Therefore, it is vitally important that you are fully aware that both Base Camps are a cooperative effort of more than one spiritual camp. One of the miracles of relief work is the cooperation of the Body of Christ at large. Simply put, we have leaders and volunteers, all from different backgrounds, denominations, and areas who are working together to **“Be The Hands and Feet”** of Jesus to a very broken community.

If you choose to work in one of our base camps, and we hope you do, it is important that you understand from the beginning that God has established a divine order to help us stay on task with His work. You will be expected to understand our established house rules and the “work order” of the residing “house pastors”. If your team has it's own leader they will be expected to work the team they bring and to maintain discipline and order within their team.
